



IRRIGATION SYSTEM

A properly maintained irrigation system is essential for keeping your landscape healthy and water-efficient. Here are some of our recommendations to ensure your system is functioning optimally throughout the season.

Schedule your irrigation start-up service which is typically performed in April. As the growing season begins, we will:

- Turn on the water – We will carefully open the main water valve to prevent pressure surges.
- Inspect the system – Our team will look for leaks, broken sprinkler heads, and any visible damage.
- Test the system – We will run each irrigation zone to ensure proper coverage and identify any adjustments.
- Identify and address repairs – If any damaged lines or components are found, we will notify you and complete repairs as needed (repair work is billed separately).

If you have a temporary irrigation system, simply install new batteries in the timer, reconnect the timer to the spigot and irrigation lines, turn on water supply spigot, and adjust the timer schedule as needed for the season.

As summer winds down, it's time to schedule your irrigation shut-down services which is typically performed in October. To protect your irrigation system from winter damage, we will:

- Turn off the water supply – We will shut off the main irrigation valve to prevent water from flowing into the system. This usually requires access inside the home to ensure the system is properly shut off and drained.
- Drain and winterize the system – Using compressed air, we will blow out any remaining water from pipes and sprinkler heads to prevent freezing and cracking.

If you have a temporary irrigation system, simply turn off the water supply spigot, remove the timer, take it indoors, and remove the batteries to prevent corrosion.
